Methods

- Harness our existing facilities & resources for use
- Expand and modernize facilities by:
 - Connecting them to Grant Funding.

EX: USDA FARMAID. Community Investment Collaborative.

- Promoting Tax Credits. Example: Wisconsin Food Processing Modernization Tax Credit equal to 10% of expansion costs
- Build a resource network to support food entrepreneurs
 - VA Cooperative Extension food scientists
 - VA Small Business Development

Methods

- Develop degree/certificate programs in food processing
- Offer (credit/non-credit) courses and workshops
- Examples
 - Southeastern Community College (NC): a certificate program in food processing
 - Southern State Community College (OH): associate degree program in food processing & technology
