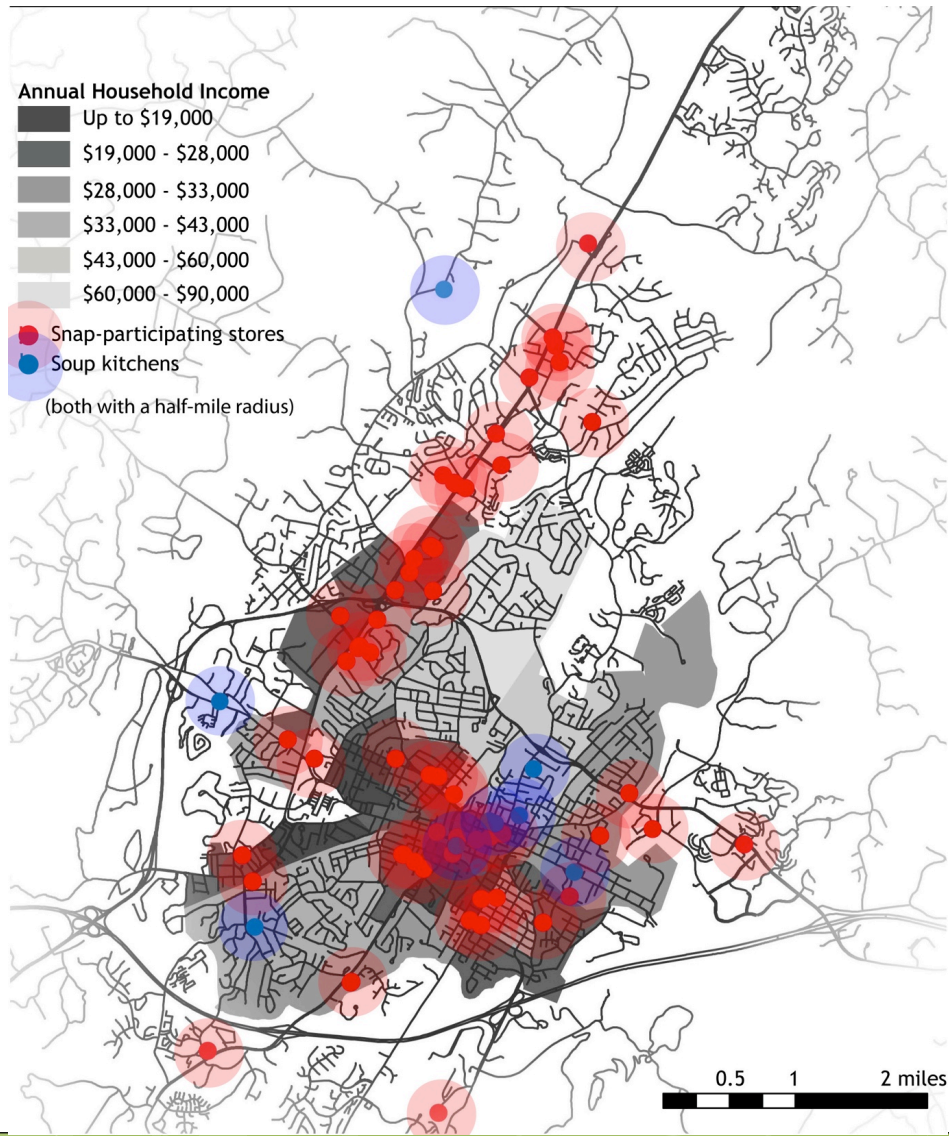


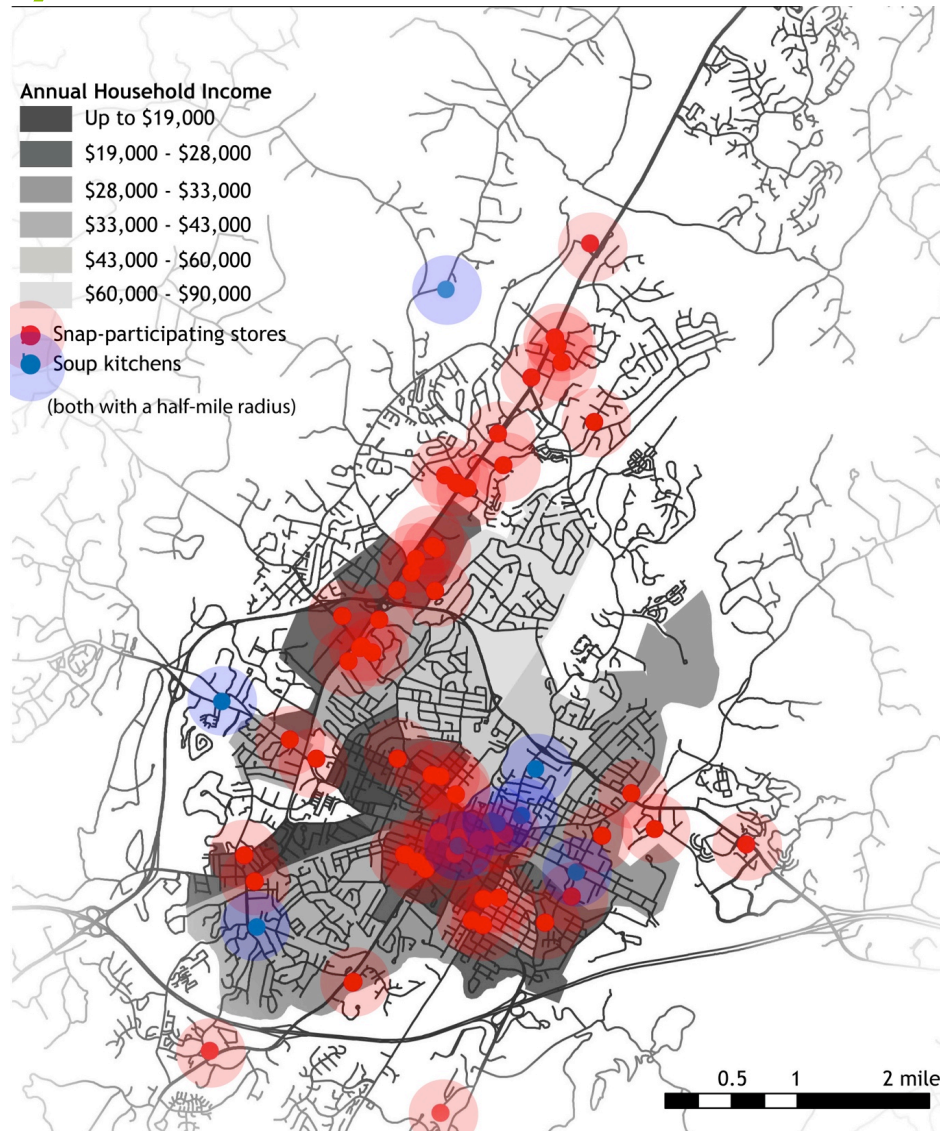

Neighborhood Profiles: Ridge



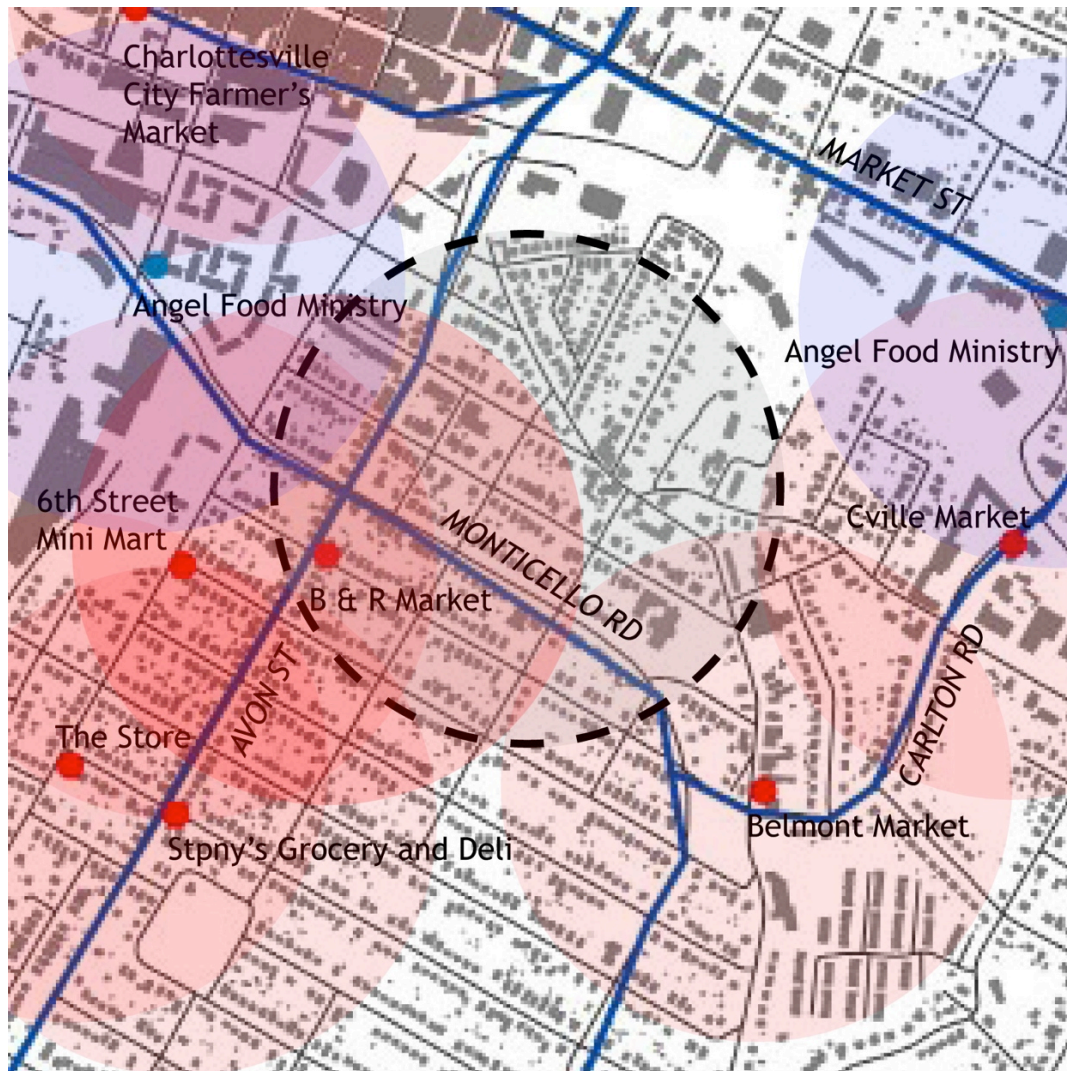

Analyzing the Maps

- Places of food assistance correspond to the populations they intend to serve
- Many SNAP acceptable locations do not have healthy food options
- Physical barriers stand between low-income individuals and healthy food option
