Reasons to Present Work in Progress

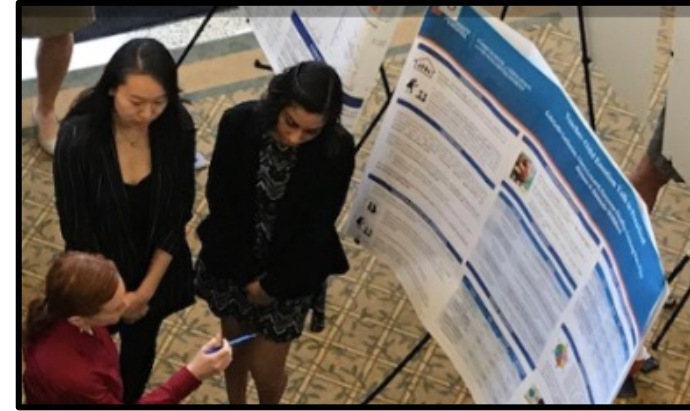
Reasons to Present Work in Progress – Be Specific

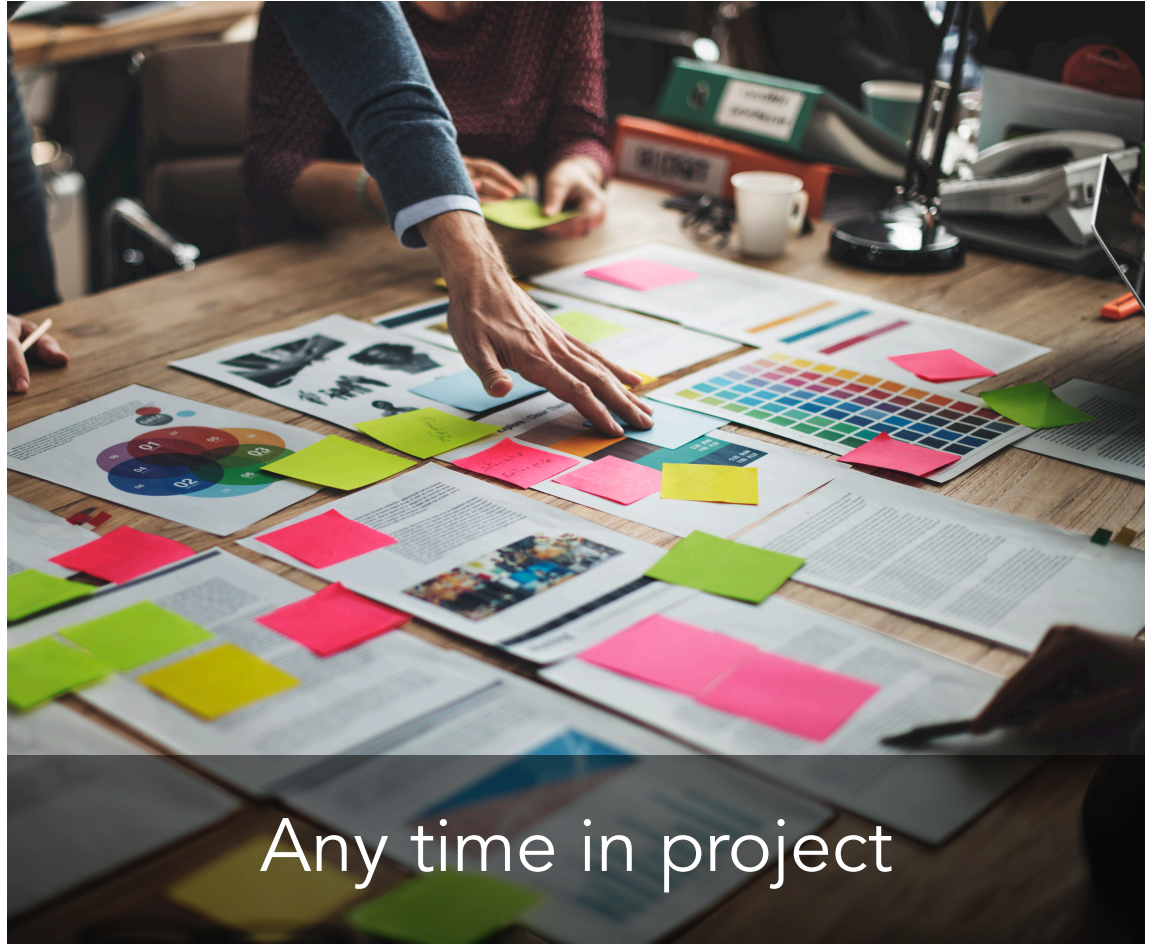

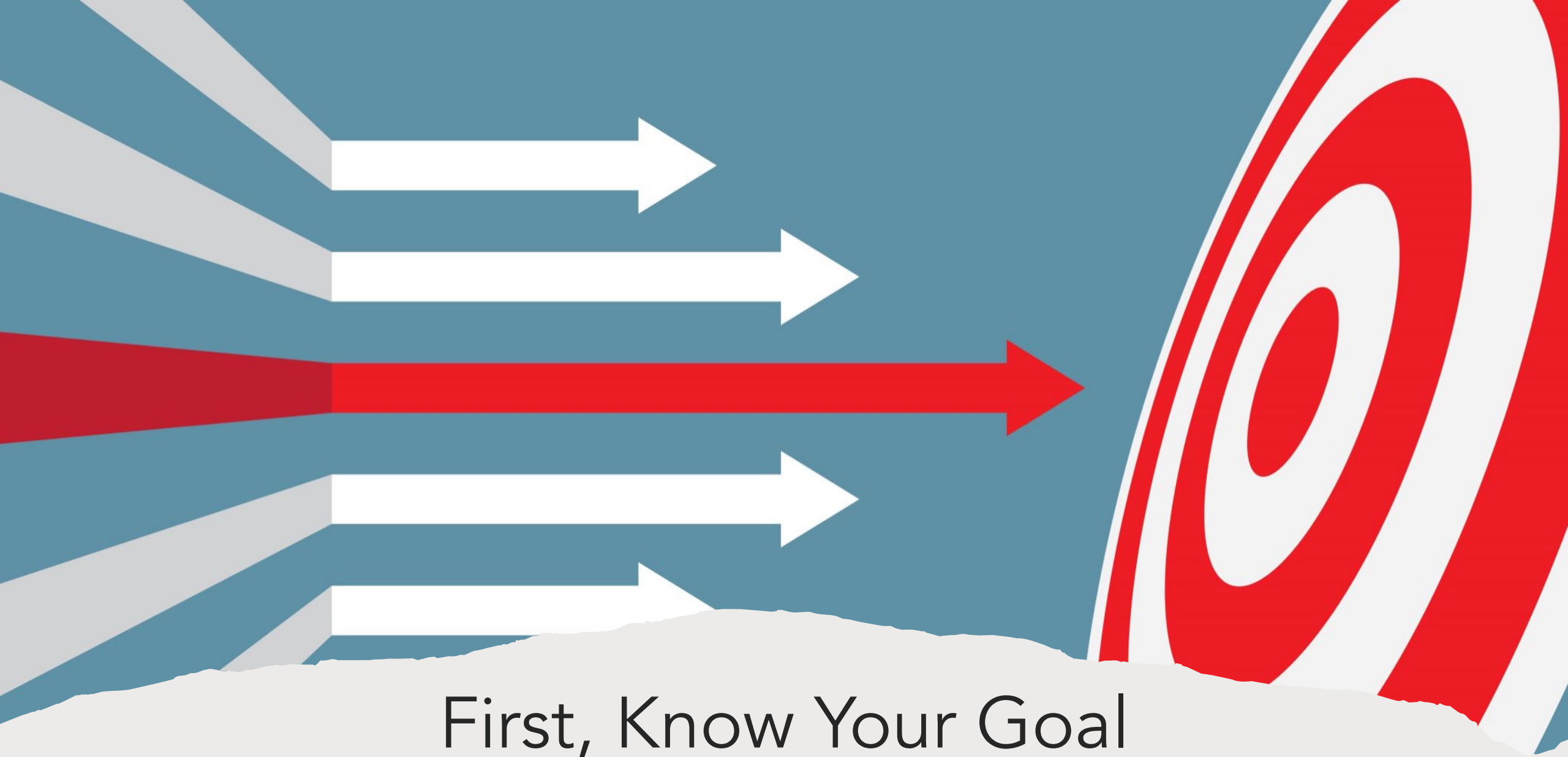

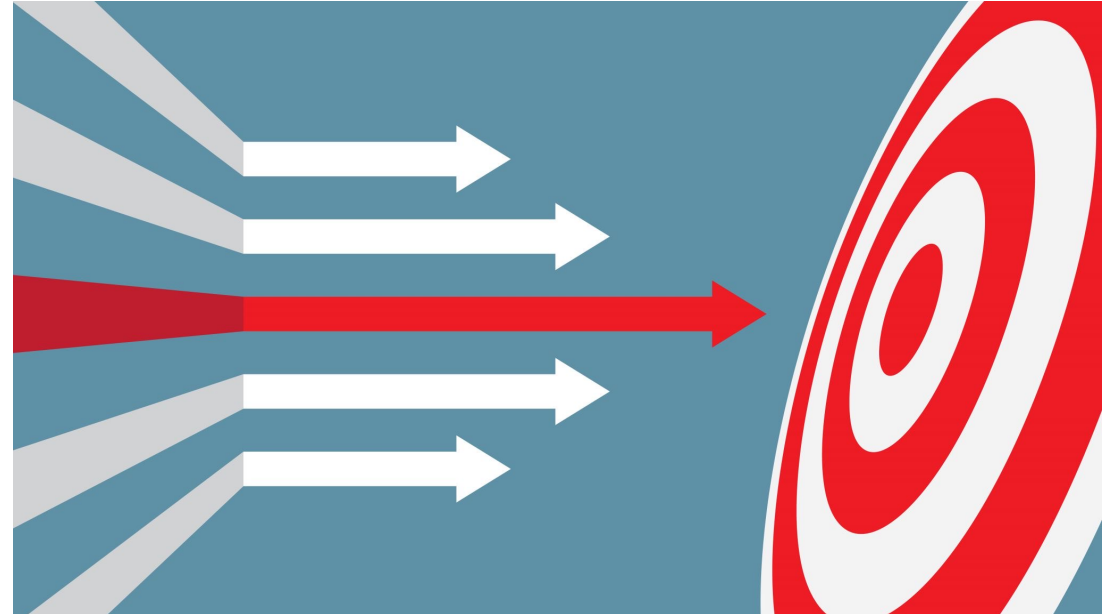


How to Prepare a Work in Progress Presentation

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Where you're hitting roadblocks

Mobilize us to help!

1. Brief Anecdote

Goals:

- Get us to care
- Help us understand the human problem
- *Show us*, don't simply tell



1. Brief Anecdote - Ideas

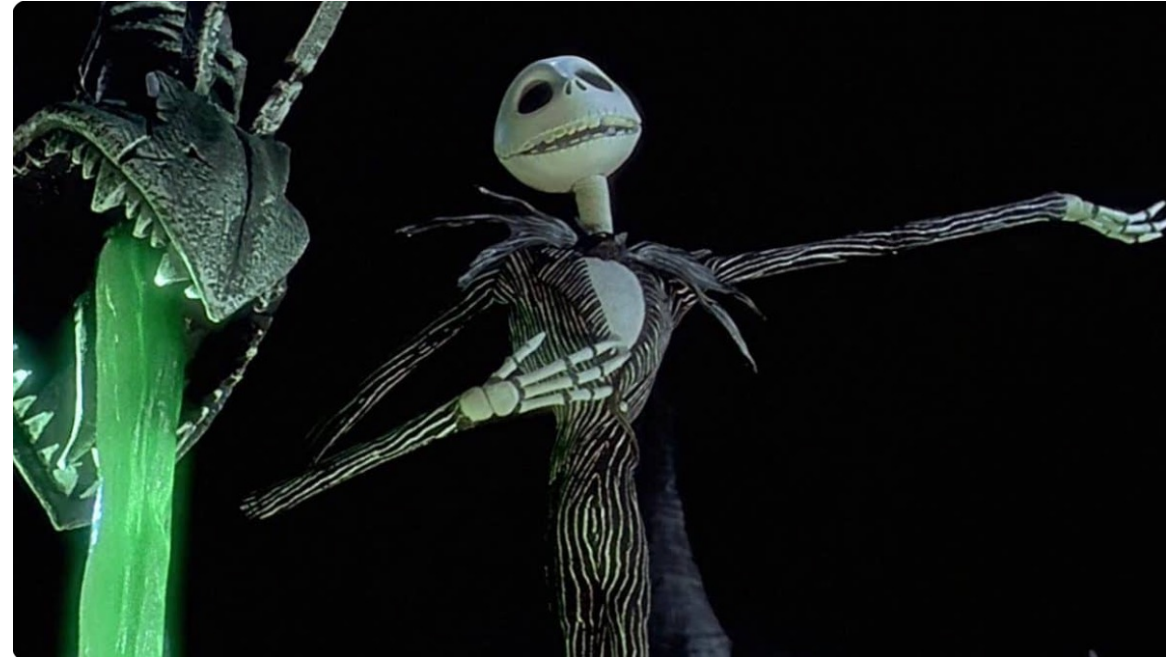
- Personal story
- Something you read in the news
- [Anonymized] story about a study participant
- Start with a specific example and then connect it to larger statistics



2. Status Quo World

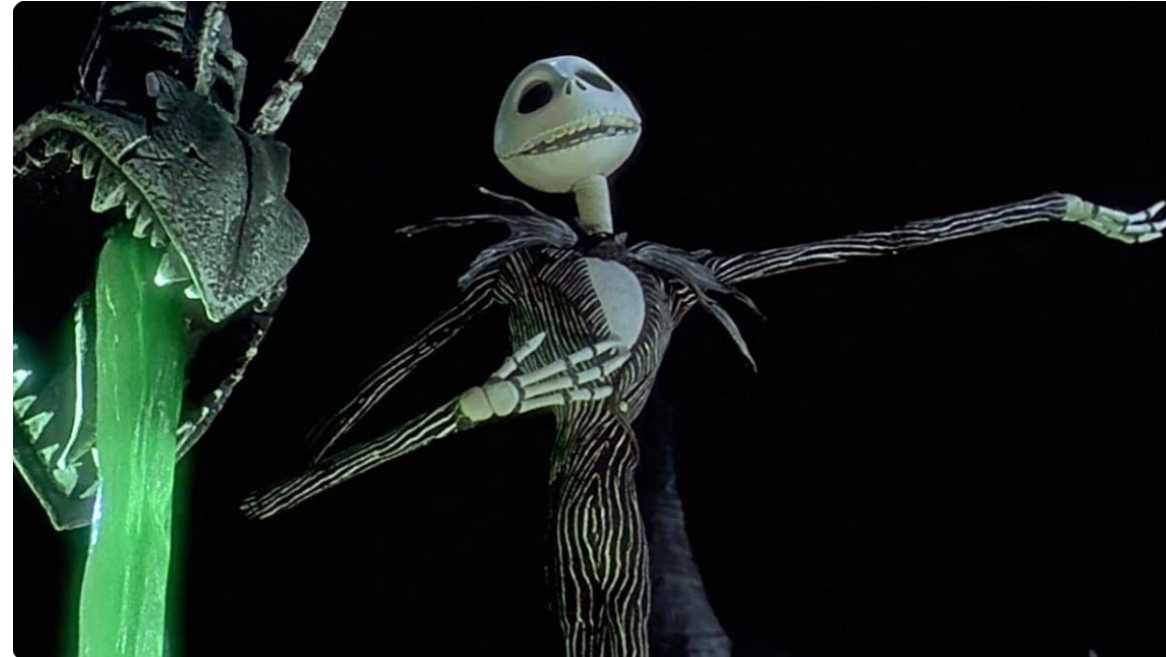
Goals:

- Show us how things currently are in your topic
- Only as much "lit review" as necessary



2. Status Quo World - Ideas

- What scholars currently say (that you want to prove wrong)
- What currently policy is (that you want to change)
- What current treatments are for the condition you study (that you want to improve)



3. Problem with Status Quo

Goals:

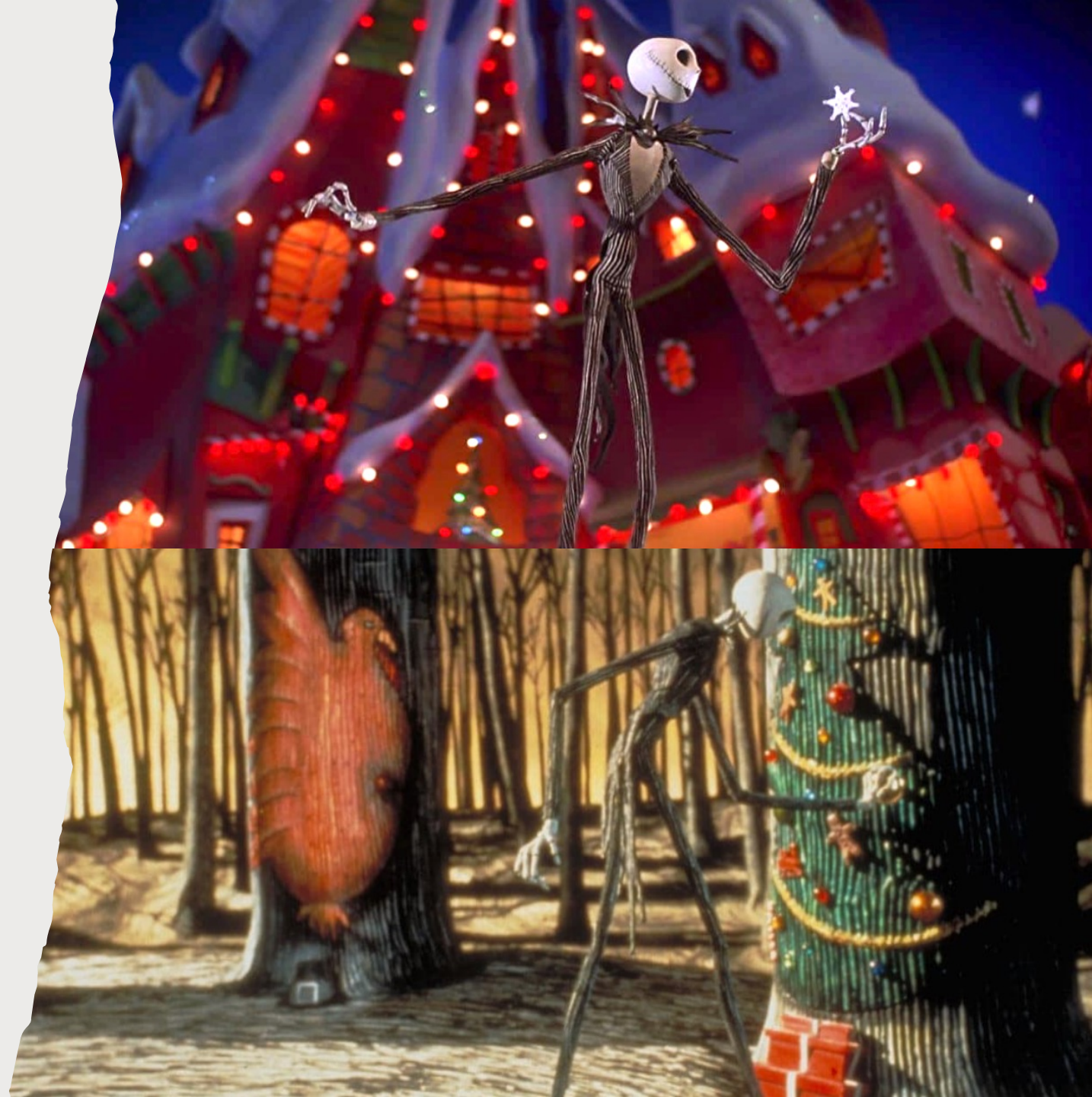
- Articulate the problem with the status quo and, thus, *your motivation*
- Lay out the stakes of the problem



4. Plan for Your Journey of Discovery

Goals:

- Show us how you intend to solve the mystery, find solutions, or answer your questions
- What's new about what you're doing?

5. Terrain Traversed in Plan So Far

Goals:

- Show us what you've done/what you know so far
- Be selective!

6. Where your investigation is hitting roadblocks

Goal:

- Help us better understand the questions you have for us

Goals:

- What you found and how it has the potential to affect the status quo for the better (research impact)
- What new questions have been identified

- What you found and how it has the potential to affect the status quo for the better (research impact)
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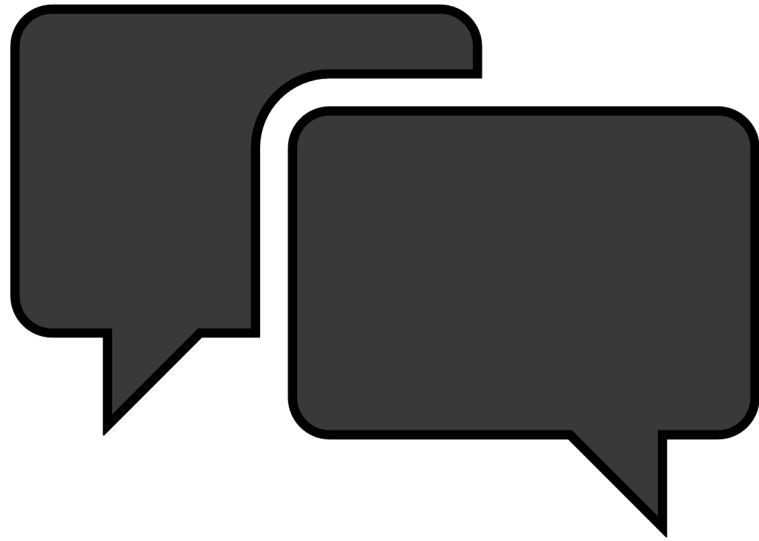


Mobilize the Audience to Help

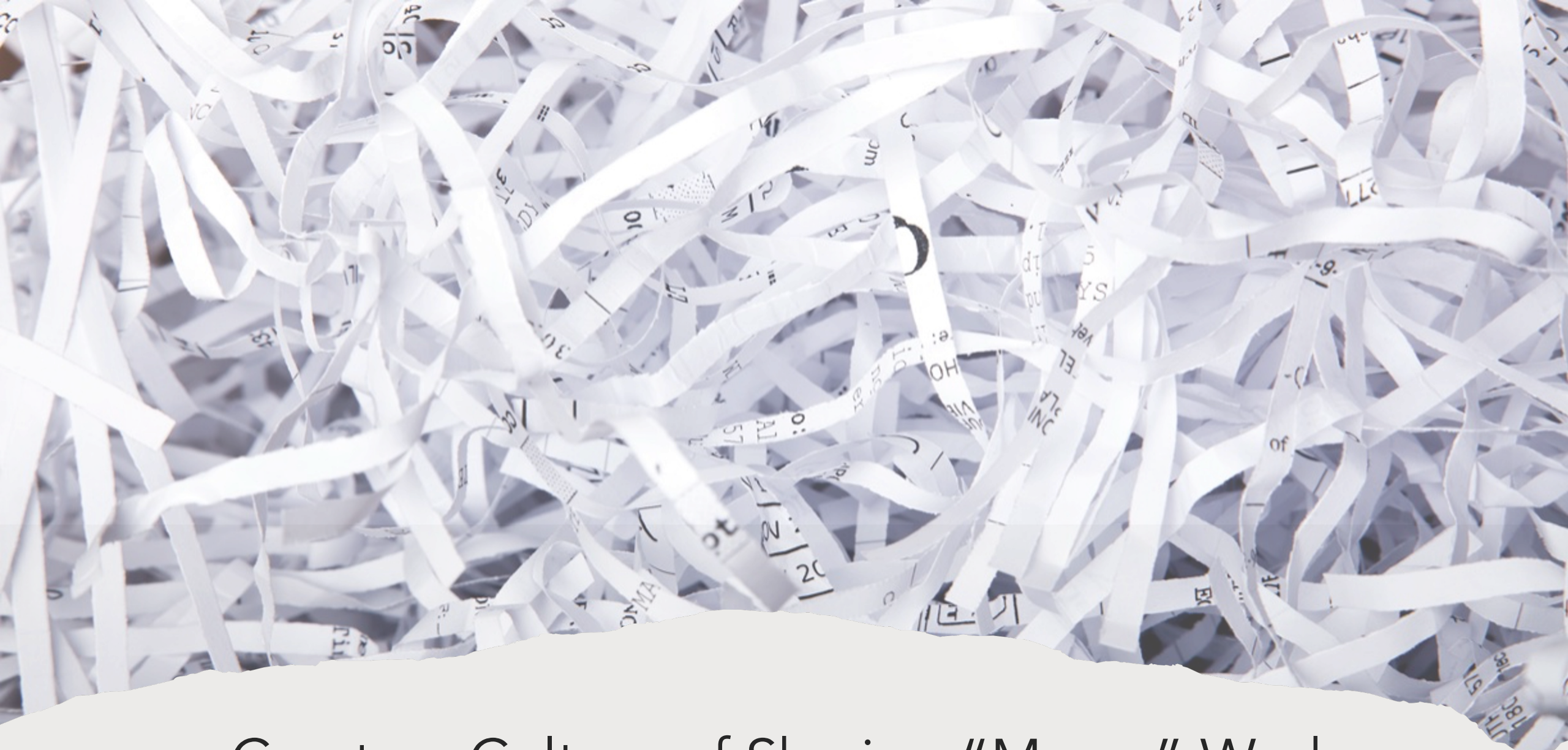

- When possible, invite peers and faculty mentors





Create a Culture of Sharing “Messy” Work

Responding to WIPs

- Share supportive and constructive suggestions
- No judgment allowed!
- Lend your perspective and expertise
- Don't be afraid to brainstorm creatively
- Say what you like about the project and what you think is working well
- Try not to stray from the objectives of the presenter

Create Opportunities to Share

- Start a dissertation workshop
- Solicit your friends for feedback (and return the favor)
- Organize WIP panel at a conference
